COST AND INVOICING

All visits to the Centre as part of the SEN programme are free of charge.

SESSION TIMES

AM sessions run from 10am - 12pm

PM session run from 1pm - 3.00pm

TRANSPORT

It is your responsibility to book and pay for transport arrangements.

Return journeys should be booked for 12.00pm and/or 3.00pm.

If using a minibus, there is parking next to the Centre, but you will require a visitor pass from reception.

CANCELLATIONS

If you need to cancel your visit, please contact the Lifeskills office as soon as possible as other schools may be waiting to book.

PARENT/TEACHER SUPPORT

Students work in small groups (around 3-4) supported by one of our volunteer guides. Please ensure that you bring sufficient staff to support each group.

ADDITIONAL REQUIREMENTS/INFORMATION

Teachers can choose which scenarios to include in order to tailor sessions to each groups' needs. A member of staff will discuss specific requirements with you, when you arrive.
